Proposed appointees:

1. Should/must be committed to senior issues
2. Should/must be able to attend the monthly Advisory Council meetings as well as a subcommittee meetings (2 meetings a month)
3. Must attend an advisory and subcommittee meeting prior to officially becoming a member
4. Must join and attend a subcommittee of their choice, which are: Health and Nutrition, Transportation, Legislative and Housing.
5. Must have transportation to travel to and from meeting sites, be computer literate, and be able to comprehend and communicate effectively in English.

Meeting Time: 2nd Friday of Each month at 9:00am

Location: Senior Centers throughout Orange County

Time Required: Approximately 8-12 hours per month.

Term of Office: The term of office is two years.

Compensation: \$30 per Advisory Council meetings (no compensation for subcommittee meetings)

Eligibility: Must be a resident of Orange County (candidate does not have to be an elected official)
